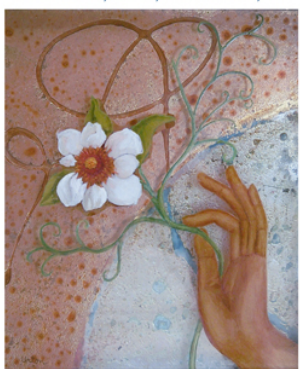

Dr. Andrew Wagner is a hospice and palliative care physician, practicing in Santa Rosa, California. He has practiced medicine for

over 30 years, first as a family physician and then as an integrative medicine practitioner. After graduating from the Academy of Guided Imagery, Interactive Guided Imagery became a foundational tool in his work. Over the last 6 years, Andrew has focused his attention on healing at the end of life, working with patients and families to reframe this transformational experience. Engaging in sacred conversations on values, meaning and purpose, and quality of life, Dr. Wagner is empowering people to honor the final stages of life with creativity, curiosity and dignity.

How did you first discover, or become interested in, guided imagery?

I have always been interested in imagery. I tend to be a very visual individual and am the type who would answer, "I see what you mean," literally. I often close my eyes as people speak, so I can more clearly see/understand what they are telling me. Before I had any real training in imagery, I had created imagery tapes for my wife as we experienced the roller coaster world of infertility and in-vitro fertilization. In the late 1990's, working too many hours as a family physician and "burning out," I went to a series of physician renewal workshops with Rachel Remen. Knowing I needed to make a career change for my well being, I asked Rachel what she thought would be an important skill for what I hoped to do with mind-body healing; she said, "Study guided imagery..." I did, and it has been the foundation of my work ever since.

Do you use guided imagery in your professional work?

I currently work as a hospice and palliative care physician. What I have learned to use from my imagery training is

the art of creating sacred space to support heartfelt conversations, and the importance of listening, of being patient, of trusting, and allowing for an organic process to unfold. I use imagery for relaxation and for pain reduction. I often use imagery to help people discover/create a safe, healing and peaceful place of respite from whatever crisis they are experiencing. I find it is a very effective message to say, "Allow yourself to be in the presence of 'wisdom'... and imagine there is something important for you to know, that will serve you on your journey... and let it be known to you, now..." My other favorite experience to use, is, "Allow yourself to be in a circle of your loved ones... greeting each of them, one by one, taking all the time you need... to feel complete... offering gratitude, and blessing each other."
